Stewardship Reflection

Twenty-third Sunday in Ordinary Time

EZ 33:7-9; PS 95:1-2, 6-9; ROM 13:8-10; MT 18:15-20

Today's readings remind us of the importance of our relationships. God created us to live in communion with Him and with one another. Our families, neighbors, friends, and parish community need us, and we need them as we grow together in holiness.

In today's Second Reading, St. Paul gives us a simple but profound guide for living in relationship with others. Echoing the words of Christ, he writes, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." Love is the guiding principle that helps us become good stewards of every relationship God has entrusted to us.

In today's Gospel, Jesus shows us what that love looks like, even when relationships become strained. He tells His disciples, "If your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone. If he listens to you, you have won over your brother."

Rather than ignoring conflict or allowing resentment to grow, Jesus teaches us to approach one another with humility, charity, and a sincere desire for reconciliation. This is faithful stewardship of our relationships.

He also reminds us of the strength found in Christian community: "Where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them."

God never intended us to journey to heaven alone. May we care for the relationships He has entrusted to us and help one another grow as faithful disciples.

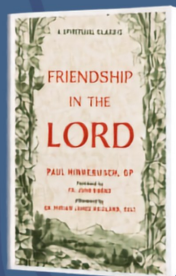

Presented above is the annual report for the fiscal year July 1, 2025-June 30, 2026 which has been submitted to the Diocese. The net ordinary income for IHM at the end of FY2026 was \$25,296.97. Budgeted collections were just slightly behind target at 98.95%, several expense lines fell below the budgeted amount. Many savings were realized from the generous donations of labor and/or materials throughout the year. ***Heartland Ministries** funds tri-parish ministries such as Catholic School support, Tri Parish Faith Formation retreats, Totus Tuus, and Parish Mission retreats. It is the hope of the parish staff and Finance Council to plan for the current needs and future sustainability of IHM. Questions can be directed to Debbie Nunnelee at the Parish Office.
